# Restaurant Reviews

## Plan De La Tour

- **L'Arbousier**, 7, Place Foch, Zone Pietonne, 83120 Le Plan De La Tour. Tel 04 94 43 11 05. An OK restaurant located in the centre of the town which is normally open when others aren't. Simple local cuisine.
- **L'Aioli**, 1 Avenue General Leclerc, 83120 Plan De La Tour. 04 94 55 58 10. As above but with a slightly more adventurous menu.
- **La Tour Du Plan**. 5 Rue Jean Jaunes, 83120, Le Plan De La Tour. Tel 04 94 43 70 05. Arguably the best in PDLT. Very hospitable, pleasant bar and food is good and fresh. The newly refurbished courtyard makes a beautiful setting for lunch or evening dining. Menu is frequently updated but LTDP is very expensive for a "local village restaurant". (But they have been know to ferry Guests to and from Les Oliviers.)
- **Les Deux Fontaines**. 7 Place Clemenceau, 83120 Le Plan De La Tour. Tel 04 94 43 75 28. [lesdeuxfontaines@yahoo.fr](mailto:lesdeuxfontaines@yahoo.fr). A delightful restaurant that has struggled in 2008. Run by Alain Dupaix, a young, talented and aspiring chef/local businessman. Worth a visit, good fresh local ingredients, but at high season be prepared for a long wait in the evening as the service is often stretched. Can be frustrating and undermines the quality of the food. When it does work LDF is good competition for La Tour Du Plan.
- **Pizzeria de Vallauray**. Tel 04 94 43 77 59. Just round the corner from Les Oliviers, turn left as you come to the road and head to Vallauray. Great thin crust build your own Pizzas. Very quickly became a Les Oliviers favourite with

both adults and Kids. Run by a family who live opposite in Vallaury and can often be seen nipping across the road to their own kitchen for more ingredients. Dad (the racing driver, all will be apparent when you get there) and Son wait the tables, Mom and Daughter run the kitchen. Very authentic, very hospitable and not a tourist in sight. Cash only and a must visit.

- **Pizza Pierrot.** 1 Rue Jean Jaures 04 94 96 13 51 / 06 16 54 77 66. New addition to PDLT for 2008 and although we are big fans of the above and Pizza Mia (see later St Maxime) this gets our thumbs up. Traditional wood burning oven for your Pizza. Open at lunch time and evening during the summer. Ring ahead for your Pizza and save your self the hassle of cooking at home. Has been known to be a centre of confusion as delivery and the limited restaurant merge into one, be patient. The best example being when we arrived for a table reservation to be presented with four Calzonnes and a beer for our 12 year old daughter, none of which had been ordered. Cash only, has great take away Lasagne sold by the kilo.

### St. Tropez

- **La Villa Hotel**, 6, Avenue Du Rivalet, 83580 Gassin. Tel 04 94 97 79 14. [www.la-villa-hotel.com](http://www.la-villa-hotel.com). Owners Mirelle and Pascal have recently, 2006, refurbished this hotel which is a short walk from St.Tropez centre. Modern rooms, “Starck” like, with a great pool and deck. Great to stay if new to the area and want some accessible accommodation that isn’t in the centre of St.Tropez

- **Hotel Sube**, 15, Quai De Suffren, 83990 St Tropez. Tel 04 94 97 30 04. [www.hotel-sube.com](http://www.hotel-sube.com). The classic “Sube” nautical themed bar, a must for breakfast or pre dinner drinks, overlooking the Port. Grab a table on the balcony, a squeeze, and soak up the atmosphere opposite the super yachts. Also a hotel.
- **La Tarte TropeZienne**, La Boutique Traiteur, Place Des Lices, 83990 St. Tropez. Tel 04 94 97 04 69. Part of a well known chain of 22 patisseries. This one serves lunch on the first floor and is a great visit on St. Tropez Tuesday’s market day. It’s balcony overlooks the Places Des Lices and again it’s classic St.Tropez atmosphere, but this time a little more real with the market below !
- **Joseph L’Escale**, Tel 04 94 97 00 63. Fab up-scale restaurant on the harbour front, weekends are lively with music and dancing. The Sea-Food’s not bad either but pricey ! Make sure you book in advance and watch out for footballers !
- **Hotel Restaurant La Bastide de St Tropez**, Route des Carles, 83990 St. Tropez. Tel 04 94 55 82 55. [www.bastide-saint-tropez.com](http://www.bastide-saint-tropez.com). In the heart of St. Tropez a place of tranquillity, a beautiful pink provencal “Mas”. Very welcome for families, they encouraged our children to play in the pool.....which is beautifully set amongst a lush, quiet (depending on your off-spring) garden. Lunch outside by the pool is a treat. Complimentary limo service to surrounding sites avoids sore feet and allows the chilled Rose to flow freely.
- **La Pesquiere et Le Mazagran et Le Revelin**, 1, 4 et 6 Rue Des Ramparts. 3, Place Du Revelin, 83990 St. Tropez. Tel 04 94 97 05 92 / 04 94 97 56 19. Fax 04 94 97 69 02. [marie-anne.jauffret@wanadoo.fr](mailto:marie-anne.jauffret@wanadoo.fr). Series of restaurants all with the same owners, on the ramparts over

looking the North Bay. Rather full of tourists, but is a nice location for a meal with a view. Food is reliable traditional fair.

### Pampelonne Plages

(To avoid peak traffic on the coastal road into St.Tropez -the N98 / D98a; From the town centre of Plan De La Tour take the D44 for Grimaud / D61 for Ramatuelle / D93 for Pampelonne. Nb these roads are narrow. Journey time to the Orangerie at peak is 30 mins this way)

- **Plage L'Orangerie,** Parking Du Boulevard Patch, 83350 Ramatuelle. Tel 04 94 79 84 74. Family Beach club, sun loungers for hire, best to go for the whole day and have lunch there. Food is fresh and simple, salads etc. Pedalos and sail boats (Cats) also for hire close by from the beach. Great day out and easy to get to "round the back " from PDLT to St. Tropez.
- **Millesim Beach Club Tabou,** Route de Tahiti, Ramatuelle. Tel 04 94 97 20 99. [www.millesim.net](http://www.millesim.net).

Nearer to St. Tropez than the above, so at the other end of Pampelonne beach, in fact the beach here is considerably smaller. Go here for a more different lunch, tends to be of African origin and the customers are of a hipper nature.

- **NiouLargo.** Relatively new entrant to the “high end” beach club fraternity. Good food, good bar, need to book. Also has a gym with the current “Power Plate” trend and resident trainer, Jean Christophe Heriveau, 06 87 95 36 54. Restaurant Tel 04 98 12 63 12. Fax 04 98 12 61 70.
- **Le Club 55.** Plage de Pampelonne, BP 55, 83350 Ramtuelle. Tel 04 94 55 55 55. Fax 04 94 79 85 00. Like the Sube and Joseph one of those places that you have to visit at least once. The food is good, the atmosphere great along with the prices. Spend a day out amongst the Sth of Frances' stars and wannabees. Hire a Ferrari, book way in advance or otherwise enjoy the wait and gawp!

### St. Maxime

- **Le Café de France.** 2 Place Victor Hugo- 83120 Saint Maxime. Tel 04 94 96 18 16. Right on the Coast road in the centre of town. Very honest French café/bistro. Tables packed together, dogs and cigarette smoke woft freely. Food is basic and fab. Sunday lunch is a must as you watch the locals disembark from their wkend Harleys for a cup of espresso.

- **Le Carillon.** 1Bd Fréderic Mistral, 83120 St. Maxime. Tel 04 94 96 07 42. Perfect family run Pizzeria. Families welcome. Just opposite the car park in the centre of town.

- **Pizzas du Golfe.** Tel 04 94 96 36 50. 13, Rue du Docteur Sigalles. 83120 St. Maxime. Fab take out Pizzeria, by the side of the main road on the way into St. Maxime central.

Email, [La.maisonbleue@wanadoo.fr](mailto:La.maisonbleue@wanadoo.fr). 2008 got off to a great start with a fabulous meal in what has now come to be our favourite restaurant in the Gulf. We can't recommend this enough and would say that this is a must visit whilst at Les Oliviers. The staff are super friendly, the atmosphere alive with locals and the food truly French and superb (try the mussels). For dinner book a cosy table inside, for lunch, go for Sunday Lunch. Do book though.
- **Creperie Pizzeria L'Oiseau Bleu,** 33, Rue Courbet, 83120 St. Maxime. Tel 04 94 96 64 25. Very good simple fresh pizzas. Located in the back streets of St. Maxime.
- **Pizza Mia.** 187 Route Du Plan, 83129 St Mazime. Tel 04 94 96 32 75 . On the left on the road directly from PDLT before you come to the dual carriage-way leading into St. Maxime. Forget the looks, forget the abundance of white vans. This is a very good honest Pizzeria. Always busy,

Pizzas are great and the menu extends to other local fare. A fab place for a very good, simple meal at a good price. Also has a take away Pizza service, handy for picking up on the way back from a “busy” day on the beach.

### **St Maxime Plages**

- **Le Saint-Barth.** Plage de La Nartelle – RN98, 83129, St Maxime. Tel 04 94 96 22 73. [www.saint-barth-plage.com](http://www.saint-barth-plage.com). Like St Maxime’s La Maison Bleue this is rapidly becoming a Les Oliviers favourite. Originally recommended by previous guests the Mitrovics in 07 this beach club is just 15/20 mins away. If you are a family of four we recommend you book a “Cabanna” which consists of 2 sun beds and a shaded wooden double cabin for the children, cost €85 for the day. Service is great, they’ll set up tables for you at the “Cabana” to have lunch on the beach and to top it off there’s a private pool. Next door, for the more adventurous, is a public water activity club with water skiing, wake boarding and pedaloes. A great day out.
- **Elephants.** Plage des Elephants. [www.plagedeselephants@yahoo.fr](mailto:www.plagedeselephants@yahoo.fr). Tel 04 94 49 11 49. Good beach club which turns into a great place for evening dining. Tuesday nights has live music and along with the setting where the restaurant lights up the beach / ocean there are some great views of the coast and Les Issambres. Very atmospheric and somewhat “Greek” like.
- **88.** Just along from Elephants. We’ve yet to try this but again the setting looks good. Tel 04 94 17 10 49.

### **Port Grimaud / Port Cogolin**

- **Café Sud.** 24 Place Francois Spoerry, 83310 Port Grimaud. Tel 04 94 56 41 79. OK pizzeria. Also does take away. Good for a walk around Port Grimaud
- **Thai Colonial.** RN 98 Port Grimaud. Tel 04 94 96 78 39 / 06 25 17 50 41. A real find this, again when the French food may get too much try this alternative. Great service, very accommodating for children and you won't find better Thai food anywhere else in Europe. (A slight generalization we know, but this restaurant deserves some hype) Try the Gambas Curry and see the size of the Gambas, green is hot, red is sweet, soups are fab, Pad Thai is great and what they cook up for children is all spice free and fresh. Well worth an end of holiday visit. Downstairs is the Thai Boat, a confectionary based Thai restaurant run by the same owners as the Thai Colonial but the dining experience is less formal, quicker, and cheaper.

### Cannes and surrounds

Famous restaurant that is also a hotel with a beautiful pool, well worth a stay, eating is also an event. In the summer get a table on the patio but one should really eat inside and soak up the incredible art (Picasso, Klee, Miro etc) that surrounds the diners.
- **Le Mas Condille,** Bd Clement Rebuffel, 06250 Mougins. Tel 04 92 28 43 43 [www.lemascandille.com](http://www.lemascandille.com). Five star hotel with a Michelin-starred restaurant, Candille and a fabulous Shiseido Spar. A real treat. Mougins itself is a beautiful village, amongst other things made famous as Picasso's home for his last 15 years.
- **Martinez Hotel,** 73, La Croisette, 06406 Cannes Tel 0492987300. [www.hotel-martinez.com](http://www.hotel-martinez.com). Another up-scale

(somewhat repetitive but appropriate description for the Sth of France) Hotel, but this time the jewel located on the sea front on the Croisette in Cannes. Refurbished in 2005. Very much worth a visit, but try to avoid festival time as you won't be able to move at the bar. In the summer have lunch at their restaurant on the beach.

- **Carlton Beach Restaurant.** 58 Boulevard De La Croisette. Tel 04 93 06 44 94. For a gastronomic treat dine here, where buffet tables piled with prawns, oyster. Langoustines, tarts, salads and deserts are a dream.
- **3.14 Hotel.** 5 Rue Francois Einesy. Tel 04 92 99 72 00. A central avant-garde hotel where the concierge won't frown when you crawl in at 5am. DJ's perform Fridays and Saturdays. Rooms are wildly Kitsch representation of continents - Europe is Moulin Rouge-themed with red crushed velvet, America is psychedelic – and the roof-top pool is a tropical paradise.
- **Hotel Best Western Mondial,** 77, Rue D'Antibes, 06407 Cannes Tel 04 93 68 70 00. [www.hotellemondial.com](http://www.hotellemondial.com). A great three star hotel, one block back from the Croisette on the shopping street Rue D'Antibes. Book one of the Penthouse rooms, with a sun deck on the roof (a bargain in comparison to the Croisette) for views over the whole of Cannes.
- **Vegaluna Plage,** La Croisette 06400 Cannes, Tel 04 93 43 67 05. Fax 0493 43 38 03. [contact@vegaluna.fr](mailto:contact@vegaluna.fr). Welcome addition to the beach front at Cannes. Food with an African twist. Pleasant, comfortable dining area, good bar and play area off to the side for younger children.
- **Le Vesuvio.** 68 La Croisette, 06400 Cannes. Tel 04 93 94 08 28 . Fax 04 93 43 94 55. Famous Italian restaurant (Pizzeria) just down from the Martinez.

- **Plage Miramar.** 64 Boulevard De La Croisette. Tel 04 93 94 24 74. [www.miramar-plage-cannes.com](http://www.miramar-plage-cannes.com). Cannes' first apero-lounge. The DJ grooves on the sand to upbeat remixes while the clientele lazes emperor-style on cream cushioned sofas quaffing Champagne and oysters.
- **C-Beach.** Boulevard De La Croisette. Tel 04 93 38 14 59. Has an inventive "tapas style" formula. Wriggle your toes in the sand as you chill out to lounge music on wicker sofas with a bottle of Chateau de l'Escarelle and a platter of squid, onion rings, chicken and mozzarella sticks.

Join smart locals for a light summer dining on sashimi, shellfish or large platters of fresh fruit. Décor is relaxing mix of decking, pebbles, large candles and silk orchids with lazy modern sax music playing in the background.

**Plan De La Tour.** From July to October the first Sunday of each month Caves Marues has a free wine tasting from 9.30am. Tel 04 94 43 71 57

**Plan De La Tour.** There's a beautiful walk down to PDLT from Les Oliviers. You need to go diagonally across the road at the end of the lane onto the lane that runs along the crest of the hill. At the bottom of the first hill take the track on your right and from there your on your own! Actually it's a series of paths and tracks that will wind their way through the valley's vineyards to the town, which should always feature on your right if walking down to the town. It's difficult to get lost. Distance is 2.5k.

There's a much longer walk above Les Oliviers across the top of hill behind the Villa, accessible either via the right hand side of the vineyard, head for the pink house directly opposite Les Oliviers or via the road back up the hill on the left. You'll find the dirt-track turning on a bend on your left. Although much longer, this provides spectacular views of the valley floor and can be reached via car.

**Plan De La Tour.** Has; two small supermarkets both with "fresh" produce, several bakeries, several restaurants, a newsagents, a Post Office, a couple of bars, florists, a general store and too many Estate Agents !

**Aqualand.** Route du Muy, 83120 St. Maxime. Open early June to beginning of Sept. 10.00 to 18.00. [www.aqualand.fr](http://www.aqualand.fr). A water extravaganza, take a picnic, book sun-loungers and stay the day.

**Aquascope.** Port de St.Maxime. 04 94 49 01 45. Boat trip on a glass bottomed “yellow submarine”. Every half hour at peak time; Adults €12, Child €6

**Arbre & Adventure.** Route du Muy, 83120 St Maxime. Tel 06 24 93 38 98. Behind Aqualand. Swing through the trees and ensure that everyone sleeps well that evening ! For young (8-12) children an ideal adventure, can get busy so worth getting there early.

**St Maxime.** Has a large **Champion** for all your grocery needs. Including those indispensable inflatable items for the beach that Dad’s seem to spend their entire holiday inflating only to find that they are left behind !

**St Maxime.** For all your hardware needs **Mr. Bricolage**, is just on from the Champion.

**St Maxime.** Avoid the traffic and take **Les Bateaux Verts** from St. Maxime Port to St. Tropez. Tel 04 94 49 29 39. Runs every 20 mins at peak times.

## **House Information**

### **Pool and Gardens**

The pool is tended daily by our neighbour opposite, George Livesey, so please don't be alarmed when you see him each morning. The Gardens are tended weekly by Stuart Worrall of Garden Services. Both will work round your presence where possible.

## **Garbage**

Please take all garbage to the end of the track through the vineyard and leave at the bins by the main road. (Nb not advisable to leave garbage out over night at the house due to wild animals)

## **Security**

Please be assured that none of the cameras are live during your stay. Whilst the hamlet is secure and our neighbours are full time residents of Le Lauva it is still advisable to be security aware and we would advise you to lock up the Villa when you are out.

## **Gates**

Please ensure that the gates are closed and are secure at night time. Apart from the boars, wild dogs are also quite common and have a habit of coming close up to properties at night time. It is also quite a good thing to keep the gates closed during the day from a security/privacy point of view

## **Electric Fence**

The blue fence is an electric fence that is on a timer and is “on” from 22.00 to 05.00. Please do not interfere or disconnect the fence. Wild boars are common in this part of France, they come down from the hills at night time and can destroy a lawn overnight.

## **Sprinkler Systems**

Les Oliviers has five systems, please do not adjust the settings, water is an extremely precious and expensive resource in the Sth of France. If for whatever reason these systems are disturbed and malfunction please inform Colin and Sandra as soon as possible.

System A. 06.15am 6 cycles of 10 mins each for the main lawn and the beds round the pool

System B. 19.00 1 cycle of 3 mins for the boundary with the vineyard.

System C. 19.15 pm 1 cycle of 3 mins for the beds around the drive at the rear of les Oliviers

System D. 19.30 pm 1 cycle of 3 mins for the beds surrounding the front of Les Oliviers

System E 19.45pm 1 cycle of 3 mins for the heather bed at the side of Les Oliviers

### **Electric Heaters**

We doubt you will need to use these ! But if you do please use sparingly as, like the water, electricity is expensive in the Sth of France.

### **Hot Water**

A large tank is heated overnight every night at Les Oliviers. We have found this to be more than adequate for our own family and our guests for our washing and cleaning needs.

### **Excessive Water or Electricity Use**

Unfortunately we do have to protect ourselves from the probability that some guests may not treat Les Oliviers with the same respect were it their own property. We reserve the right to recharge for any excessive use of water or electricity. We will of course supply copies of bills upon request

### **The Garage**

Is locked for a reason and is off limits to all guests at all times. It does though contain the fuse box. Should a fuse blow please contact Colin and Sandra. Please also refrain from interfering with our car which is on a trickle charger connected to the Garage.

### **The Pool House**

Is also locked for a reason.

### **Les Oliviers' Pet**

Our children have befriended a wild ginger cat, now known as Snuffles ! Food can be left out for Snuffles, who has a bowl in the Kitchen. Snuffles has a habit of living in the bamboo reeds in the right hand corner of Les Oliviers. If you do leave food out please remember to close the gates to keep any roving dogs out, thank you from Elen-Tay and Jak.(Included at their request !)

### **Septic Tank**

Is located to the side of the house on the boundary by the vineyard. It is a typical French countryside septic tank and may occasionally “waft” in hot weather. We tend to discourage our children from playing on that side of the house, we’d encourage you to do the same. Please do not disturb the cover to the tank. Should the smell become permanent and unpleasant please inform Colin and Sandra. (We have the tank emptied every year, its capacity is for three years worth of continuous use). Problems normally occur due to inappropriate items being flushed down the toilet, please do obey the signs in each of the bathrooms.

### **Broadband Router.**

Is plugged in on the Mezzanine. Please do not unplug it. For connection instruction please see the printed out instructions within this guide. Name is Livebox 3128. Security Key is 99EE BBB4 62D8 0FB4 F9F7 10AE51. Do not amend any other router settings.

### **Sunbed / Chair Cushions**

Please place both the sunbed cushions and the patio chair cushions in the box provided after use each day. Please don’t leave them out overnight. This will preserve there condition as well as ensuring wild animals don’t use them for claw and teeth practice ! Thank you.
